# Ground Transportation Prices – 2012



We offer ground transportation throughout the Yukon. In addition, we can recommend or arrange air charters for trips that involve flying in to, or out from, rivers and lakes.

Our ground transportation prices are calculated based on the distance travelled, type of road, time required, fuel consumption, and other factors. Two vehicle types are used:

- extended cab pickup trucks or Suburbans that can accommodate four passengers, with two canoes on the roof and gear in the back. These vehicles have four-wheel drive, facilitating travel on rougher roads. Suburbans may also be used as trailer towing vehicles.
- 15-passenger, one-ton vans, occasionally pulling a trailer. We prefer to limit passengers to 12, allowing more room inside for day packs. Trailers are flat decks, with or without canoe racks, and take all the large or heavy gear.

Prices shown are flat rates between Whitehorse and the destinations noted, and include the vehicle, fuel, driver, and transportation of all gear. You will need transportation to your put-in point, plus pick-up from your take-out point. As an example, if you were paddling the Teslin River to Carmacks, you would need a put-in trip to Johnson's Crossing, plus a pick-up in Carmacks.

#### Transportation Surcharges:

Our transportation pricing will be subject to surcharges for out-of-the-ordinary circumstances. These include:

- Having our driver(s) travel outside of the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. will be subject to a surcharge, determined by the request and time involved.
- Having our driver(s) stay overnight while waiting for you to arrive, such as if your charter flight cannot pick you up on the arranged day, and we are not advised of the change in time. In this instance, a typical surcharge would be in the order of \$200.
- If weather conditions are such that the air charter company advises they may not be able to pick you up the next day, we reserve the right to return to our base and charge for another round trip.
- Other factors beyond our control, such as unusual road conditions, forest fires, etc., may be subject to a surcharge. For example, if a road washes out, creating a delay, we reserve the right to consider a surcharge.
