- We carry only quality boats suitable for wilderness trips. All conventional rafts are self-bailing, and brands include Maravia, Riken and NRS. Boats are available in 14', 16' and 18' lengths, with either inflatable thwarts or a rowing frame as desired. Note that while 18' boats are available with thwarts, we do not recommend paddling a raft that large.
- Catarafts are typically Aire, and we carry 16' Jaguarundi and 18' Leopard models, with either 9' or 10' long expedition frames.
- Frames are from NRS and a cooler or dry box is included as the rowing seat. We will work with you to configure the gear to your specifications. Please note that some options will be at additional cost.
- For full information on equipment normally included with either paddle or rowing set-ups, please refer to the Boat Equipment Checklist sheets. For additional items, please see the Optional Raft Equipment Checklist.
- Our boats and gear are carefully inspected after each trip, and if necessary, returned to exceptional condition before being rented again, to ensure your satisfaction.
